

THE 2012 LORI ALLYN GROVES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

I. Purpose of the fund is:

- A. To be a continual living memorial of Lori Allyn Groves, former student, performer and dance instructor in the San Diego Civic Dance Arts program who was killed in an auto accident on Sunday, July 21, 1985, at the age of 21.
- B. To provide scholarship stipends for dance instruction for San Diego Civic Dance Arts members who have demonstrated exemplary interest, attendance, cooperation and dedication to their dance studies.

II. Goals of the Fund are:

- A. To perpetuate Lori's love of dance and enthusiasm for life.
- B. To perpetuate the fund.
- C. To provide an incentive for students in the San Diego Civic Dance Arts to excel in dance to their full potential and enhance their appreciation of dance.

III. Classifications of Eligibility

- A. Members of the San Diego Civic Dance Arts may apply if they meet the following minimum requirements:
 1. Student has been enrolled in the San Diego Civic Dance Arts for at least one full year and is between the ages of 5 and 19.
 2. They have maintained a 90% attendance record with minimal to zero tardiness all year round for their entire enrollment in the San Diego Civic Dance Arts.
 3. Students have demonstrated a dedication to and involvement with the program as well as leadership qualities within the program that go above and beyond regular class attendance.

IV. Application Process

- A. Applications may be obtained by sending a #10, self-addressed, stamped envelope to the San Diego Civic Dance Association, Attn: Scholarship Committee, 2125 Park Blvd., San Diego, CA 92101. **They may also be obtained from your dance instructor or on our website at www.civicedancearts.org.**
- B. **As San Diego Civic Dance cares for the environment, preferred method of submittal is electronic (via email).** Email your completed application, and essay to: sdcdascholarships@gmail.com.
- C. If you are unable to email your application, you may mail your completed application, to San Diego Civic Dance Association, Attn: Scholarship Committee, 2125 Park Blvd., San Diego, CA 92101. **Your application must be postmarked by Friday March 16th, 2012. Do not turn your application in to your teacher. Your teacher WILL NOT accept it. Interviews will take place Saturday May 12th, 2012.**
- D. Each eligible applicant will be required to meet with an independent, unbiased interview group with the date and time to be set by the Scholarship Committee. All applicants will be scored on teacher recommendations and evaluations, application and essay as well as your interview.
- E. **IMPORTANT: You will be notified of your scheduled interview time VIA EMAIL. If you do not have access to email, please provide a self-addressed stamped envelope for notification.** You must meet for the interview to qualify for the merit scholarship as there will be no exceptions to these dates.
- F. **Please list all SDCDA teachers that you have taken with for classes, workshops and summer dance camp.**

V. Awards

- A. Scholarships may be awarded to San Diego Civic Dance Arts students for classes in the San Diego Civic Dance Arts program for one year. Total amount of classes is determined by funds available and amount of qualified candidates. These scholarships may not be awarded if there are no qualified candidates. Scholarship Award amounts are determined by the Scholarship Committee.
